Transitional Housing Guidelines

1. Clean bathroom(s) and shower room daily. *
2. Clean stairs and hallways as needed (at least once a week). *
3. Clean kitchen as used (no dirty dishes in the sink). *
4. Clean any other rooms after use.
5. Provide your own disposable items, like toilet paper, paper towels, paper plates, etc. (The church will supply trash bags for the kitchen trash can.)
6. No smoking in the building. Place cigarette butts in the can at the back entrance.
7. No alcohol, illegal drugs, or weapons are allowed on the premises.
8. Maintain quiet when the building is in use, and between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM.
9. No visitors between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM.
10. Use of the kitchen is prohibited when preschool is in session (8:30-11:30 AM, 12:00-4:30 PM, Mon-Thur.)
11. Children must have adult supervision at all times.
12. Donations to the church are appreciated but not expected.
13. Use of the church phone for incoming calls and outgoing local calls is permissible. Special permission must be requested for outgoing long distance calls.
14. Personal property on the premises is subject to search by authorized church personnel at any time.
15. Remain fully dressed at all times outside the personal room, bathrooms, or shower room.
16. Unmarried couples are not allowed to sleep in the same room.
17. No pets.
18. Actively pursue permanent living arrangements.
19. Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in immediate dismissal.

* When multiple households/occupants are in residence, responsibilities for cleaning these common areas are to be equally shared.
