

CBC Transitional Housing
Purpose, Goal, Objectives

Purpose: To invite people in transition to experience the love of Christ by offering them a safe place to stay amid the support of a loving church family.

Goal: To provide temporary shelter for homeless people who are actively pursuing permanent housing, in fulfillment of God's directive to the church to love our neighbors.

Objectives:

- To provide a safe, comfortable living environment for each resident.
- To provide a shared kitchen for meal preparation.
- To provide shared bathroom and shower facilities.
- To provide a limited amount of storage for household belongings.
- To provide a phone for incoming and outgoing calls (long-distance paid by resident).
- To provide a list of services the residents may contact for further assistance.
- To provide a clear list of expectations for residents at the outset of their stay.
- To review at least weekly with the residents how they are meeting the stated expectations.
- To offer the warmth, support, acceptance, and services of a loving church family to those residents who would be interested.
- To coordinate all objectives under the oversight of the CBC Elders, Pastor, and Housing Manager.
